



## ZION MENNONITE CHURCH - ARCHBOLD, OH

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Zion Mennonite Church was in need of replacing a worn out asphalt parking lot. Representatives from the church took bids on both asphalt and concrete, and the concrete came back at a savings of \$5,000.00. They also sited life cycle cost advantages, minimal maintenance and aesthetics as other reasons to go with concrete. The 39,000 sq. ft. parking lot was milled and then a 4" unbonded concrete overlay was placed using 3.0 lbs. / cu. yd of FORTA-FERRO<sup>®</sup>. **A broom finish was then applied to the surface resulting in minimal fiber exposure on the surface.** Control Joints were cut 6' on center. FORTA-FERRO<sup>®</sup> was used to not only **assist with temp/shrinkage cracking, but to add a level of toughness and durability to the concrete.**
