



GAS STATIONS - BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Two gasoline stations, North & South Side, needed to be rebuilt. Part of the old pavement was a Jointed Reinforced Concrete Pavement (JRCP) and part of it was a hot mix asphalt (HMA) system. **The JRCP was demolished and rebuilt using FORTA-FERRO[®] reinforced concrete to extend joint spacing and reduce curling.** An Ultra-Thin Whitetopping (UTW) reinforced with fiber was best suited for rehabilitation of this pavement.

UPDATE

North Side was surveyed and was in excellent condition. Only a few cracks have appeared in the corner of some slabs (less than 0.5 mm wide) and then does not affect pavement ride quality. South Side is also in excellent condition. **The performance evaluation of these two gas stations shows that the vast majority of the surface is in great shape after 1 year of use.**
