



## STATION SQUARE - PITTSBURGH, PA

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The owner of The Glass House is constructing a 319-unit apartment building in downtown Pittsburgh, PA. Pittsburgh was known as the glass capital of the United States at the turn of the 20th century, so an all glass apartment building in the heart of the city is a nod to that local history. FORTA-FERRO fibers will be used in the concrete floor of this building, while the rest is comprised of mostly glass with beautiful 360-degree views. The total project size is 610 cu yds and used 2,440 lb of FORTA-FERRO macro synthetic fibers. **Not only will using fibers allow the contractor to save two days in their schedule but will allow them to save money in the future.**
